Clear Copy of Birth Certificate - for Kenyans below 18 years of age. 9. 2 recent coloured pilot size photographs, must be 2.5 by 2 cm. 10. 1 recent coloured passport size photographs. Additionally, non- Kenyans are required to: 1. Apply for a Student Visa via the website <a href="https://fns.immigration.go.ke">fns.immigration.go.ke</a> and submit a copy of the application to the school prior to admission. 2. Submit a clear passport copy with bio data & visa pages.
