Be holders of the Degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.Ch.B) of the University of Nairobi or equivalent from a university recognized by the Senate 2. Be registered by the Medical Practitioners and Dentists Board of Kenya or any other regulatory body 3. Have passed a pre-entry interview organized by the Board of the School of Medicine 4. Have certificate of good standing from the regulatory body 5. Have letter of reference from two academic referees 6. Have a valid medical indemnity cover throughout the training period 7. Foreign applicants shall provide certificate of proficiency in English and may be required by the school to appear for a pre-entry interview |
| Application Procedure | Application forms are obtained from the UNES finance offices on payment of a non-refundable application fee of Kshs. 3000/= for Kenyan citizens and US\$ 50 or its equivalent for non-Kenyan citizens. The application fees MUST be paid in Cash at any Barclays bank branch a/c no. 030-073-1023948 and the banking slip to be taken to UNES in Gandhi Wing Room G3 for issue of receipt before collection of the application forms. The completed forms accompanied with copies of degree certificates and academic transcripts are submitted to the Board of Postgraduate studies which is located at the main Campus on the ground floor of Gandhi Wing. |
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
